Rules:

All Breed Entries: All entries, stall reservations, and and RV Reservations must be accompanied with payment in full. Entries will be accepted by mail, email (with credit card payment), on line at mjmshowservices.com Completed entry form must be postmarked no later than ~~July 1, 2020~~ **July 20, 2020**. On-line entry available at www.mjmshowservices.com

All Breed Cross Entries: Horses and riders may enter as many All Breed classes as they desire as long as they comply with the class specifications. Walk Jog exhibitors may enter 3 gaited classes.

Returned Checks: Any person writing a check on an account with insufficient funds will be charged a returned check fee of \$50.00.

Post Entries: Post entries will be accepted after July **20**, 2020 with an additional fee of \$35.00/horse.

Refunds: Entry refunds may be granted **providing a written veterinarian or physician certificate is received with refund request**. Refunds may be held until up to 30 days after the completion of the show at show management's discretion. No Refunds will be issued for "No Shows". Stall refund requests **MUST** be submitted within 7 days of the completion of the show and **MUST** be accompanied by a veterinarian certificate. All refund requests will be reviewed by the board/show committee. If refund is granted, a 50% office fee will be retained. Exhibitor will have the option to apply stall credit in the amount of 80% of amount paid for a future show taking place in the current year. Refunds made on credit cards will not include the 4% credit card fee.

Combined Classes: Show management reserves the right to combine and/or cancel classes, if there are fewer than three (3) entries in a given class. Anyone who has entered a cancelled class will be refunded their entry fee.

Bedding: Bedding is available on site at LAEC. Place all feed and bedding orders directly with LAEC Feed and Bedding.

Awards: It is the exhibitor's responsibility to pick up any awards at the conclusion of the show. There will be a \$15 fee if you want your awards mailed to you after the show.

Dogs: All dogs shall be on a leash at all times and shall be secured and not roaming free during the horseshow. If loose dogs disrupt classes during the show they will be sentenced to Goldmine Doggy Jail and owner must post bail.

Stalls: Stalls will be assigned based on the order in which the **paid stall reservations are received**. Stall fees must accompany stall reservation. Stalls will be assigned on a first come first served basis.

Ties: In the event of a tie for High Point Division Awards, ties will be broken by, A. the person showing in the least amount of classes, B. If both exhibitors showed in an equal number of classes, the winner will be determined by the person winning the most first places.

Protests: All protests must be made in writing by the end of the show, and a protest fee of \$100.00 must accompany the protest. If the protest is found to be valid, the \$100.00 fee will be refunded.

Entry Forms: All entries must be submitted on the forms provided by The Goldmine Circuit, or the show secretary. All contestants must check out at show office or leave an open check for completion of entries.

Gate Calls: A thirty (30) second gate call will be enforced. Please make every effort to be at the gate when your class is called. Contestants needing extra time for tack changes, etc. must notify the show personnel prior to gate call. The gate will be closed after 30 seconds. Late arrivals will not be permitted to enter the class.

Youth 11 & Under W/T Division: Rider must be 11 years of age or younger on January 1 of the current show year.

Youth 18 & Under Division: Rider must be 18 years of age or younger on January 1 of the current show year.

FAB 4: The **FAB 4** classes will pay \$100 to the 4th Place winner

Battle Of The Breeds Classes – Open to any/all breed with cash payout to the top 3 placings

Pro/Am Western Pleasure – Amateur shows on the rail first, during line up, riders will switch, trainer mounts and will be judged on the rail. Amateur & Trainer scores will be combined to determine class winners.

Versatility Mule Class: Cash Prizes 1st – 3rd (Jackpot with \$250.00 Added)
Judged 35% on a specified pattern – 35% on Pattern – 30% on Conformation.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY

I will be helpful, caring and considerate to others. I understand that I will be responsible for what I say and do, and that I am subject to disciplinary action if I am found guilty of unsportsmanlike conduct. Horses are entered at your own risk & are subject to all applicable rules, under which these classes will be conducted. In case of death, accident, injury or theft, to the exhibitor, their family, horses or property, no claims will be honored against Southwest Show Management, any/all breed associations and/or Reno Livestock Events Center and all of those associated with any or all of the above mentioned organizations.
